Prince of Songkla University Visiting Professor Appointment

Definition

Prince of Songkla University ('the university') appoints visiting professors to promote and facilitate collaboration among academic staff. The appointment aims at promoting research output in pursuit of the university's mission.

The university may confer a visiting professorship on a non-employee during the period of their association with the university.

Objectives

- 1. Target research focus on infectious diseases and cancer.
- 2. Broaden the research base of the university on cancer and infectious diseases.
- 3. Harness the academic and professional talent in the community to advance the university's research.
 - 4. Build and establish international research networks.

Principles

- 1. An applicant deserving of an appointment as a visiting Professor must be a Professor or an Emeritus Professor in any instutition.
- 2. All appointments a visiting Professors will normally have a term of one year per appointment.
- 3. The conditions of appointment, rights, and obligations of visiting Professors are set out in this policy.
- 4. Confirmation of an appointment is conditional upon the person returning a signed copy of the letter of invitation.
- 5. Prince of Songkla University is designated to be an additional affiliation of the appointed visiting Professor. Visiting Professors will be able to cite the name of Prince of Songkla University only for research but not for any private matters.

6. All appointments of visiting Professors are at the discretion of the university and may be terminated at any time by written notice from the university.

Benefits

- 1. Visiting Professors will be given a lump sum of 500,000 baht for travel, accommodation, and honorarium expenses while performing relevant activities for the university.
 - 2. The university will facilitate on visas application.
- 3. Visiting Professors are eligible to apply for external research grants in collaboration with academic staff at the university.
